Consider Homestead Hospice when...

- ER visits become more frequent

Each patient will have a complete assessment by licensed physicians, nurses, social workers, chaplains, dieticians and CNAs. The assessment will guide the team to a complete and individualized plan of care that addresses the patient's medical, social or comfort needs.

All care, equipment, supplies, medications and doctor visits related to the hospice diagnosis are paid for by the hospice. Hospice is funded by Medicare, Medicaid and some private insurance companies.

All services are provided regardless of the financial ability of the patient or family.
